Complete Refresher Training in the comfort of your own office or home. The minimum (and average) time requirement is 3 hrs (depending on your level of experience in performing DOT tests. The max time in the online (face to face) format is 3.5 hours (again, depending on your level of experience as you can always have more time available to you).

Your appointment must be “uninterrupted time, so please plan accordingly when scheduling your session. The time is YOURS to complete training and proficiency, and to ask questions or get clarifications from a content expert.

Sessions are by prepayment only (prepayment secures the appointment on the calendar. Payments are non-refundable. However, fee may be used for the same or similar service at a later date if you need to postpone for any reason. Session must be scheduled no less than two weeks in advance.

When Scheduling Your Session...

Prerequisite: Initial Training: the DOT requires that in order to become officially qualified to perform DOT drug and alcohol testing services, and to be in compliance with federal regulations, one must complete training followed by a demonstration of proficiency. ***Evidence of having completed initial training and proficiency is required when scheduling Refresher Training.***

Refresher Training: this brochure highlights refresher training for you. Initial training is “good” for 5 years; then in order to continue performing these services, one must complete refresher training.

Need more than 3.5 hours? No problem. You should feel comfortable and confident about getting the time you need to complete training and demonstrate proficiencies! You may want additional time allotted to you for answering questions, getting clarifications, guidance – whatever your needs are – they will be met. An additional fee may be required but you can inquire about that.

Typically the individual who has not done much testing at all since having completed initial training is a good candidate for needing additional time. Please inquire by calling (507) 455-1025.
